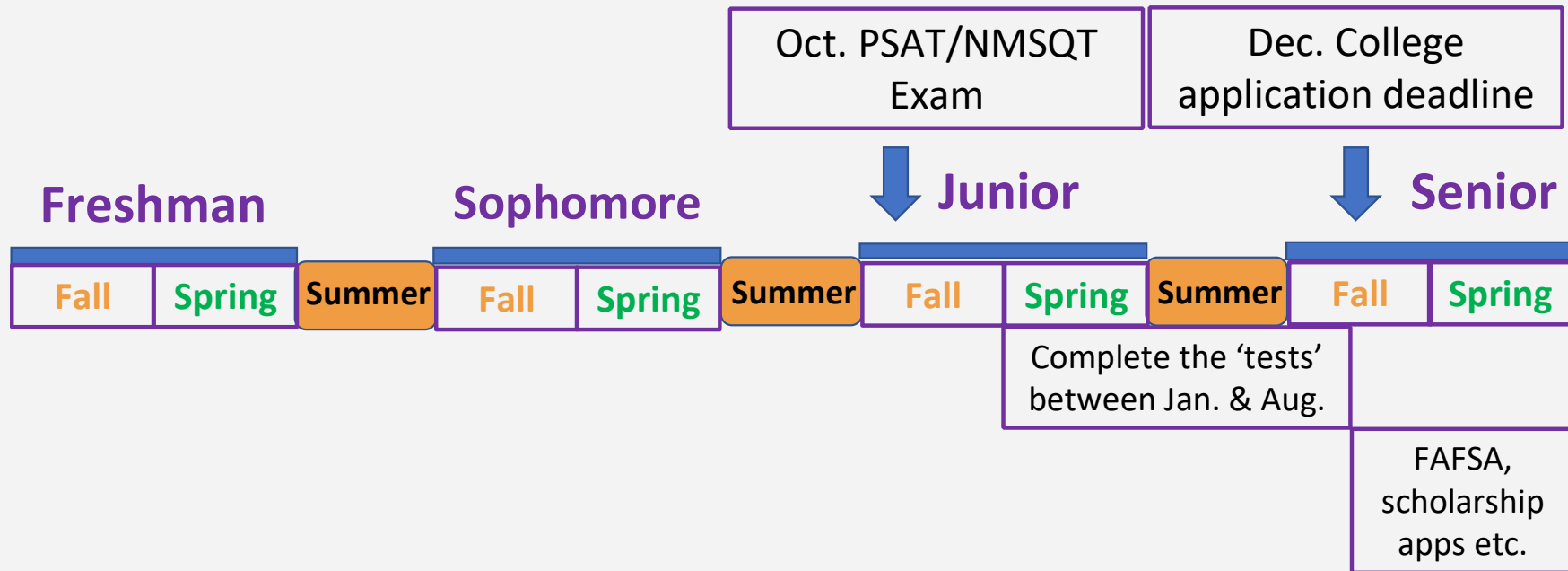

PROGRAMS & SCHOLARSHIPS





UNIVERSITIES ADMIT STUDENTS BASED ON

1.

Three years of high school coursework and cumulative GPA.

2.

Currently enrolled senior year courses.

3.

Course rigor – Honors, AP, IB, Cambridge etc.

4.

Standardized test results – ACT or SAT.

5a.

Admission decisions are always provisional

5b.

Admission may be revoked if the student does not satisfactorily complete senior year.

ADVANCED PLACEMENT (AP) PROGRAM



- **AP courses** are rigorous, college-level classes in a variety of subjects that give students an opportunity to gain the skills and experience colleges recognize.
- Colleges and universities may grant placement and course credit to students who obtain high scores on the examinations

AP tests are scored on a 1 to 5 scale as follows

- ✓ 5 – Extremely well qualified
- ✓ 4 – Well qualified
- ✓ 3 – Qualified
- ✓ 2 – Possibly qualified
- ✓ 1 – No recommendation





DUAL ENROLLMENT

What is dual enrollment: Get high school and college credit at the same time!

Eligibility: Current Miami Dade County public schools, private, charter schools, or home school students.

The credits that students earn at MDC count toward high school graduation and can be applied to a college degree or certificate.

Benefits:

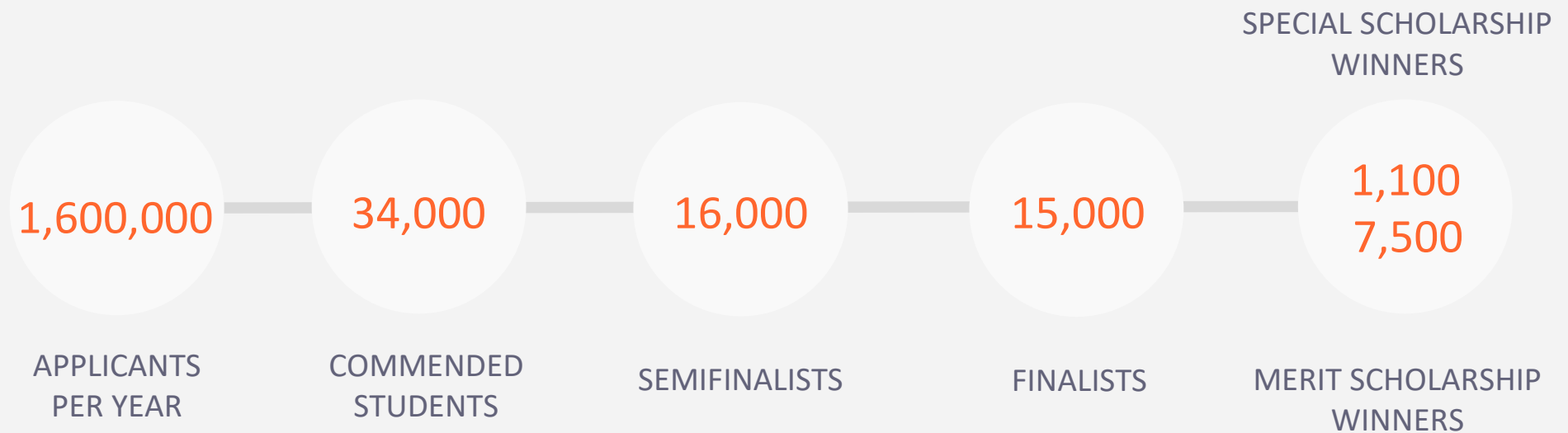
1. Enriches the course opportunities for outstanding secondary school students
2. Shortens the time to attain a college degree or certificate
3. Saves students and parents money, as dual enrollment students are exempt from paying tuition and fees
4. Provides students with college credit that is transferable to a college or university

National Merit[®] Scholarship Program (PSAT/NMSQT[®])



Take the qualifying test in the third year of high school (grade 11, junior year).

Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) is the application for government financial aid.

Types of financial aids:

- ✓ Grants → Free money
- ✓ Work study → Free money
- ✓ Loans → To be paid back

Who: The student and the parents should complete the form

When: End of the fall semester for the next academic year (earlier the better 😊)

Where: Online - <https://studentaid.ed.gov/sa/fafsa>

- No earned college credit except for dual enrollment (DE).
